



Dr. Mohammad Ali Modjtahedi (Sept. 23, 1908 - July 1, 1997) was a lifetime educator, highly respected university professor, and the cherished principal of the prestigious Alborz High School in Tehran, Iran. He was also the founding President of the Sharif University of Technology (originally Aryamehr Technical University) and Chancellor of Tehran Polytechnic University (currently Amirkabir University of Technology).
